**RESOLUTION ON CONDUCTING THE 7TH HERITAGE DAY
AND 2nd LITTLE MISS F.A.A.T. ON AUGUST 9, 2014**

Introduced by Jaycel Montealegre

WHEREAS, the Filipino American Association of Tennessee was formed for the following purposes:

- “3) To enhance the history and cultural heritage of the Filipino American community through humanitarian, medical, sports, cultural and religious program.*
- 4) To promote the general welfare of the Filipino American community in Tennessee.*
- 5) To foster, enhance, support, maintain and preserve a harmonious social, civic and educational relationship among members and other ethnic community organizations.*
- 6) To encourage and promote a harmonious relationship among Filipino Americans and other ethnic American communities in the United States of America.”*

WHEREAS, in view of such goals under its Constitution, F.A.A.T. continues to endeavor and promote the Philippine heritage through a day of showcasing Filipino art and culture, including but not limited to Filipino dances, songs, food, sophistry, architectural designs, apparel and other culturally-related matters;

WHEREAS, F.A.A.T. has been very successful in conducting the Heritage Day for six (6) times and has undoubtedly promoted the harmonious social and civic and relationships among its members and the general public at large;

WHEREAS, F.A.A.T. also started a pageant for a cause through the Little Miss FAAT (LMFAAT) where Filipino-American children will gather together and raise money, the proceeds of which shall be shared by the parents of the participating contestant and FAAT which shall earmark it to a charitable event, organization or otherwise, designed to assist the underprivileged regardless of age, gender, creed, nationality or cultural orientation;

WHEREAS, per Resolution No. 7 dated 25 January 2014, the current Board of Directors by majority of votes has decided to combine the events together and under such pretense it has later been agreed to have both events conducted back-to-back on August 9, 2014 at St. Edwards Gymnasium, at 188 Thompson Lane, Nashville, Tennessee 37211 (See attached flyer);

WHEREAS, per Resolution No. 14 Announcing the Resignation of Mila Vazquez who was originally the chairperson of the Heritage Day and the abandonment from office of co-chair Mina Galamgam, Program Director, as cited in Minutes of Meeting dated 8 June 2014, the chairpersons of the Heritage Day and 2nd LMFAAT are Lynette Ferrer and Jaycel Montealegre, respectively, to be co-chaired by Raquel Osborne and Joy Matanguihan-Gallagher;

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has agreed to disburse funds for purposes of covering the necessary costs of conducting the event, including the awards for key persons in the community for their remarkable contributions and the pageant-winners' awards;

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors shall continue to endeavor to promote Philippine Heritage and culture among its members and to other ethnic groups even after the conclusion of the event;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, BY UNANIMOUS VOTES OF THE 2013-2014 BOARD OF DIRECTORS PRESENT, TO HOLD THE 7th HERITAGE DAY and 2nd LITTLE MISS F.A.A.T. (2LMFAAT) AT ST.EDWARDS GYMNASIUM ON AUGUST 9, 2014 AND TO DISBURSE FUNDS NECESSARY FOR SUCH PURPOSE.
