RESOLUTION ANNOUNCING THE APPOINTMENT OF MS. RAQUEL OSBORNE AS THE NEW SOCIAL SECRETARY

WHEREAS, the position of Social Secretary is now vacant;

WHEREAS, Ms. Raquel Osborne is a Filipina, born in the Philippines and raised in Northern Territory, Australia;

WHEREAS, Ms. Osborne and her family reside in Nolensville, Tennessee;

WHEREAS, per Ms. Osborne’s resume (attached hereto):

1. She graduated from Centralian College in Australia with a degree in Hospitality and Small Business Management and furthered her education at the National School of Business in Nashville, Tennessee with a diploma in Business Administration;
2. She has worked with several companies with a focus on human resources, administrative work, leadership, marketing and sales;
3. She has volunteered in several non-profit organizations including the Frist Center for the Visual Arts, United Way, Life Community Church and Christian Women Job Corp., performing various duties and tasks, among the most distinct is being a Mentor, Event Coordinator and Team Leader;

WHEREAS, the position of Social Secretary under Sec. 4 of Article V of the current FAAT Bylaws include the following duties:

- i. Make arrangements on all social programs approved by the Association.
- ii. Assist the Recording Secretary as needed.
- iii. Must keep, maintain, sort, and file all records of the Association

iv. Must take custody of all tangible assets and supplies. Must make inventories of all assets at least twice a year. Must maintain a permanent record and disposition of all properties. Must ensure their good working conditions and storing facilities.

WHEREAS, Sec. 1(e) of Article V of the Bylaws empowers the President to “fill vacancies in elective positions with the approval of the Executive Committee;”

RAQUEL MENDOZA OSBORNE AS THE NEW SOCIAL SECRETARY OF THE ORGANIZATION; EFFECTIVE 2 FEBRUARY OF 2014, HER APPOINTMENT IS VALID UNTIL REVOCATION OR UPON EXPIRATION OF THE BOARD’S TERM.
